



### **#3506 KASHMIR OPPOSITE CABLED PULLOVER**

#### **TRENDSETTER YARNS USED:**

Kashmir #64-10(12,14,16,18)/50gr.  
Trendsetter Needles #8,9.

**SIZES:** Pet(30"), Sm(33"), Med(36"), Lg(39"),  
Xl(42"). Finished size is about 3" larger.

**GAUGE:** With #9 needle and Kashmir in  
Stock St.; 18sts = 4".

**NOTE:** Depending on size worked, cable pattern  
may not be centered as shown in photograph.

#### **STITCHES USED:**

##### Rib St.:

Row 1: \*K2,P2\*. Rep \*to\* as possible across row.  
Row 2: Work stitches as set on the needle.

##### Cable St.:

Row 1,5,7,9: \*P2,K6\*. Rep \*to\*, end P2.  
Row 2,4,6,8,10: \*K2,P6\*. Rep \*to\*, end K2.  
Row 3: \*P2,C3B,P2,K6\*. Rep \*to\*, end P2(P2/C3B/P2,  
P2,P2/C3B/P2,P2).  
C3B=Sl.3sts to cable hook in back,K3,K3 from hook.  
New Row 3: \*P2,K6,P2,C3B\*. Rep \*to\*, end  
P2(P2/K6/P2,P2,P2/K6/P2,P2).

## **#3506 Kashmir Opposite Cabled Pullover - Knitting Instructions**

**BACK:** With #8 needle and Kashmir, Cast on 72(80,88,96,104)sts. Work in Rib St. for 2". Change to #9 needle and Stock St. until 14(14,14 1/2,15,15)" from the cast on. Bind off 5(5,6,6,6)sts at the beginning of the next 2 rows. Decrease 1 stitch each end every other row 5(6,6,7,8)x. Continue on remaining 52(58,64,70,76)sts until the armhole is 6(6 1/2,7,7 1/2,8)". Bind off the center 28sts. Join new yarn and work both neck edges at the same time. Continue, decreasing 1 stitch each end every other row 3x. When the armhole is 7(7 1/2,8,8 1/2,9)" Bind off remaining stitches.

**FRONT:** With #8 needle and Kashmir, Cast on 72(80,88,96,104)sts. Work in Rib St. for 2", Increasing 10sts evenly across the last row. Change to #9 needle and work in the Cable St. pattern until 11(11,11 1/2,12,12)" from the cast on. Continue in Cable St. pattern, changing to New Row 3 for pattern so that cables will reverse as shown in the picture. Continue until 14(14,14 1/2,15,15)" from the cast on. Bind off 5(5,6,6,6)sts at the beginning of the next 2 rows. Decrease 1 stitch each end every other row 5(6,6,7,8)x. Continue on remaining stitches in pattern as possible until the armhole is 4(4 1/2,5,5 1/2)". Bind off the center 16sts. Join new yarn and work both neck edges at the same time. Bind off 2sts each neck edge 1x. Decrease 1 stitch each neck edge every other row 7x. Continue on remaining stitches until the armhole is 7(7 1/2,8,8 1/2,9)". Bind off.

**SLEEVES:** With #8 needle and Kashmir, Cast on 36(36,38,38,40)sts. Work in Rib St. as possible for 3". Change to #9 needle and work as follows:

9(9,10,10,11)sts Stock St., 18sts Cable St., 9(9,10,10,11)sts Stock St.

Work in patterns as set, Increasing 1 stitch each end every 5th row 14x. **AT THE SAME TIME:** When 13(13,13,13 1/2,13 1/2)" from the cast on, Change to New Row 3 for Cable St. pattern so cable will reverse and continue until all increases have been worked and 64(64,66,66,68)sts are on the needle. Bind off 5(5,6,6,6)sts at the beginning of the next 2 rows. Decrease 1 stitch each end every other row until the cap is 5(5 1/2,6,6 1/2,7)". Bind off 2sts at the beginning of the next 2 rows. Bind off remaining stitches.

**FINISHING:** Sew shoulder seams closed. Set the sleeves to the body by centering the cap to the shoulder seam and working down each side. Sew the remaining underarm and side seams closed. With #8 circular needle, Pick up 92(92,96,96,100)sts around the neck edge. Work in Rib St. for 3". Change to #9 needle and continue in pattern for 4". Bind off in pattern.
